ETC_11 devising theater workshop



In May 2011, the 6th Community Theater International Festival will be held at the Autonomous University of Madrid. This is an innovative event that intends to be a meeting point for European experiences that use theater as a tool for social intervention.

A devising theater workshop will be carried out during the festival, in which the members of the invited companies -plus other participants, will create collectively a show that will be openly performed at the end of the workshop.

The poem 'A Invenção do Amor' by Daniel Filipe will be the starting point of the workshop. The conflictive relationship between love and social order will be the axes around which all our work will swing, placing us in a moment in which political powers suppressed all social and individual freedom: the 40s and 50s in Spain and Portugal.

The workshop will be honored with the participation of the next companies:

- **Autonomous University of Madrid Drama Group**, from Spain.
- Legislative theater project **Estudiantes por empréstimo**, from Lisbon (Portugal).
- **The Sejny Chronicles**, a Borderland Foundation project, from Poland.

The devising theater workshop will be led by Marco Ferreira, who is responsible of the educational department at Baal_17 –a Portuguese company that works with teenagers in rural environments. Marco has a broad experience in the Theater of the Oppressed and other forms of participative theater in which the audience takes part in the play, realizing the power of the tools they have to provoke social change.
